Following your vasectomy:

Couch potato

May shower next day

Take pain meds every 4 hours for at least the first five days:

Ibuprofen (motrin/advil) 400mg

Plus

Tylenol (acetaminophen) 650 mg

Or instead of Tylenol

Percocet or Vicodin

You will get very “black and blue”

The wound may drain. Not to worry.

Remember we talked about the “granuloma” blow out

Signs of infection: red and tender wound with thick “orange peel” skin. Call me about this.

The stitches will dissolve and fall out in 10 to 14 days. The wound will open and drain a little bit of fluid. No worries.

You are “firing live rounds” until proven otherwise.

Following 20 -30 ejaculations bring a semen specimen to the office in a twist top specimen container.
